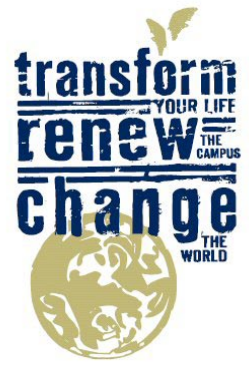


Campus Intern Year:

A 1 year staff internship with InterVarsity Christian Fellowship in the Northern Illinois and Northwest Indiana Division



What

Campus Intern Year is a one year program for a small team of interns to do ministry with experienced IV Campus Staff Members or Area Directors on campuses in Chicagoland. Interns are given ministry assignments on campus, are trained along with other staff, and regularly meet as an Intern Year Team to debrief, pray and receive supervision with the Intern Director.

How you spend your time on campus will be decided by your coaching CSM/AD. Possibilities include working with small group leaders, leading a strategic small group, NSO, working with evangelism plans, follow-up, pioneer work. Campus placement will be determined by your interest, our staffing needs and where the Holy Spirit is leading.

Interns will also have the opportunity and responsibility to raise a small budget that will include their salary and training expenses. Though this does not cover health insurance, we will work with you to find affordable insurance options. Additionally, you would receive excellent fundraising training in April to equip you to raise the needed funds and have the spring and summer to raise your budget.

After one year, the commitment is over. Your commitment will be done at the end of the Chapter FOCUS week for the school you are assigned to. If you desire to come on board as a full time Campus Staff Member, you may apply if that is where you feel God leading you. Participating in Intern Year does not assure you of being hired as a CSM, but it is excellent preparation for such a position. If you are hired as a CSM, you will stop your campus work in late spring and begin full time fund development.

Why

Intern Year may be a great option for you for many reasons:

An opportunity to give back to InterVarsity:

We hope and pray that your life has been transformed by Jesus through the ministry of InterVarsity at your campus. Your staff worker has poured his/her life into the chapter and into you, and you've gained a real vision for how God can move on a college campus. Intern Year could be a great way to give back a year to this ministry that has changed your life.

An opportunity to discern:

We have encountered many students and alum who are interested but not sure if they are called to ministry, in general or specifically on staff with InterVarsity. This commitment provides you with an entire year to decide if you are called to ministry through hands-on experience, supervision and leadership development by veteran staff, and ministry training that you can use for the rest of your life, whether you pursue long-term ministry with us, other ministries or in the workplace.

The need:

Our staff team has been working hard to deepen and develop ministries all over our division, but the reality is that we have many more campuses, students, and people groups on campuses that we are not reaching or that are without staff. Our dream is to staff every campus in our Division and have ministries that reach the whole campus. You have the opportunity to work with staff to meet these needs and help build the Kingdom in Chicagoland.

Who

Campus Intern is for growing and maturing Christians who have earned a bachelor degree. IVCF experience as an undergraduate student is very helpful – but not required. Applicants must demonstrate that they are committed to the work of IVCF and are able to work under the guidance and leadership of the Campus Staff Members. Applicants must be available to participate in all intern-training events.
